

LARGE VEHICLES & MODERN ROUNDABOUTS

Large vehicles, especially trucks with trailers, often need extra space in roundabouts. The modern roundabout at 67 Street and Orr/Johnstone Drive has a truck apron around the centre island to accommodate large vehicles.

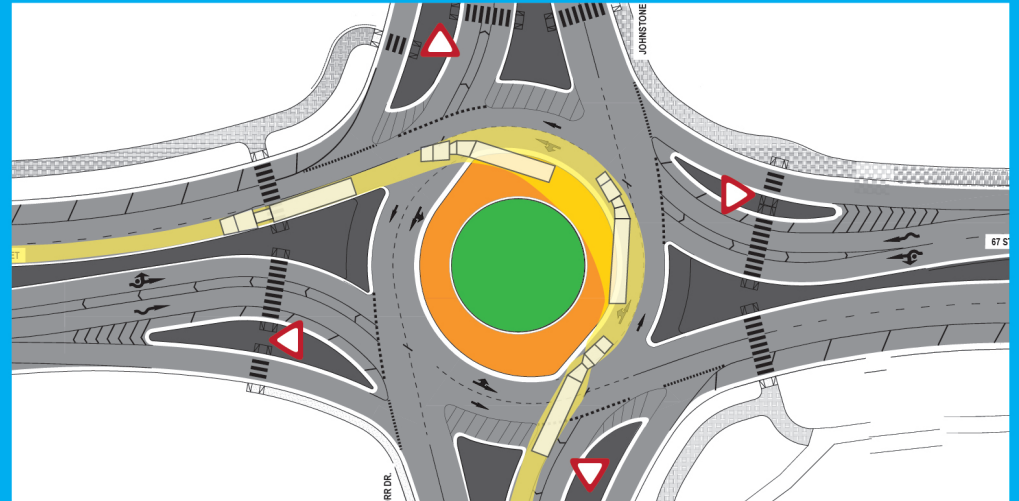
All of the same rules of the road apply for large vehicles in roundabouts:

- 1.** As you approach the roundabout, slow down and use the overhead signs and lane markings to pick your lane based on whether you're going right, left or straight through.
- 2.** Signal as you would at a traditional intersection.
- 3.** Yield to all lanes of traffic in the roundabout. Stop only if necessary and proceed when it's safe to do so.
- 4.** Stay in your lane until your exit and signal right on exit.

LEFT TURNS:

- Stay in your lane as you approach the roundabout, then stay close to the left curb line and use all available space to enter the roundabout.
- As you proceed through the roundabout, straddle both lanes or the centre island truck apron if you need more space, and watch for traffic.
- Continually check all mirrors until you clear the roundabout.



RIGHT TURNS OR GOING STRAIGHT THROUGH:

- The roundabout at 67 Street/Johnstone Drive has dedicated right turn lanes. Enter the turn lane and merge with traffic as you exit; you may need more than one lane as you merge.
