WHAT'S INCLUDED IN THIS BYLAW:

Fireworks Bylaw 3626/2019 regulates the sale, possession and use of fireworks (consumer, display and pyrotechnic) in city limits. This bylaw ensures fireworks are used safely by persons with proper training and qualifications.

WHAT THIS MEANS FOR RESIDENTS:

A permit is required to discharge fireworks. Permit requirements include:

- Permit holder is a Fireworks Supervisor or Pyrotechnician.
- Written consent from land owner where fireworks will be discharged.
- Description of fireworks event and site plan.
- Payment of permit and inspection fee(s):
\$58.25 for permit, \$116.50 for site inspection and \$233 for after hours site inspection.

The sale of fireworks is not permitted in the city.
