- WHEREAS:** Prostate cancer is the most common cancer to affect Canadian men; and
- WHEREAS:** One in eight Canadian men will be diagnosed with the disease in his lifetime; and
- WHEREAS:** When detected early, the survival rate for prostate cancer can be close to 100%
- WHEREAS:** The vast majority of cases, approximately 97 per cent, occur in men aged 50 years and older;
- WHEREAS:** Increased awareness and open conversations about prostate cancer encourage screening, early detection, and ultimately save lives;

I, Cindy Jefferies, Mayor of the City of Red Deer, encourage Red Deerians to help raise awareness and support for prostate cancer research and support all affected by prostate cancer.
