



We are building fiber-optic infrastructure near your property.

You may have noticed construction activity in your neighbourhood. That is because we're getting your community ready for a fibre optic network which will give you access to the best internet technology for speed and reliability.

One aspect of the fibre build includes the installation of fibre-optic infrastructure in select areas. This can include, but is not limited to, above-ground access cabinets or flush-to-the-ground service boxes, as seen in the images to the right. We have identified that a piece of infrastructure will be required adjacent to your property or within the designated right-of-way space.

This infrastructure is required to support the many homes and businesses within your community and it's necessary for it to be easily and safely accessible by technicians. When possible, we will install these in the boulevard; however, if no space is available, it will need to be installed within the utility right-of-way based on approved city permits. Placement of the cabinet along public corridors is carefully considered and every option to place them discreetly is explored in consultation with your municipality.

Please note that signage will be posted to notify if parking will be affected in the area. After the work has been completed, we will restore all property back to its original condition. In some circumstances, this may require waiting until the weather permits to allow proper grass regrowth and hard surface restoration to be completed.
