Terms and Conditions:

1. The applicant is to be the sole beneficiary of the parking pass.
2. When displaying the parking pass, the applicant must adhere to all parking signs and regulations, in accordance with the Traffic Bylaw 3186/97, and is only exempt from on-street parking meter fees, but not parkade and parking lot fees.
3. The applicant understands that the parking pass will expire December 31st of each year, and is required to obtain a new sticker each year from the Royal Canadian Legion, Branch #35.
4. If lost or stolen, replacement passes are issued by Inspections and Licensing, City of Red Deer. A \$20.00 replacement fee will be applied.

QUALIFYING CRITERIA

Veteran Parking Passes are available to any veteran who has been Honourably Discharged after serving:

A. In WWI, WWII, Korean War or the Gulf War as a member of:

- The Canadian Forces,
- An Allied Force,
- Canadian or Allied Merchant Navy, or
- The Ferry Command.

B. As a member of the Canadian

Forces meeting the National Defence Professional Classification requirements (MOC qualified)

C. In United Nations or NATO

Operations as a member of:

- The Canadian Forces,
- The Royal Canadian Mounted Police,
- Other Canadian Polices Forces, or
- An Allied Force.

Documentation Required:

It is the responsibility of the veteran to ensure that copies of all service documents are provided. These documents must be in English, or a certified translation is required for other languages.

Reserve personnel must have completed the equivalent of 1,065 days of service to qualify and have been Honourably Discharged.

Veterans

- Canadian Forces Discharge Certificate
- Canadian Forces Certificate of Service (both sides)
- Allied Forces Discharged Certificate of Service
- Canadian or Allied Merchant Navy Service Record Book

RCMP / Canadian Police Force

- A letter from the RCMP Commanding Officer certifying the veteran's service in a United Nations or NATO Operation.
