

Purpose:

- 1 To increase awareness of vehicle accident costs.
- 2 To establish guidelines for assigning responsibility for costs associated with vehicle accidents involving The City of Red Deer.

Policy Statement(s):

- 1 **Accidents Involving Vehicles:** In the case of *any* vehicle accident involving a City vehicle in which damage occurs that is determined to be preventable, the sub-department involved will be responsible for any, and all damage, save that covered by the insurance.
 - 2 **Accidents Involving City Vehicles and Private Property:** In those cases where damage has occurred to private property associated with a City vehicle, the sub-department involved will be held responsible to cover those costs if the accident is determined to be preventable.
 - 3 **Accidents Involving Two City Vehicles:** If two City vehicles are involved in an accident, the vehicle declared by the Accident Investigation Committee or the R.C.M.P. to be at fault, will be responsible to cover all damages.
 - 4 **Non-Preventable or No Fault Accidents:** When an accident is deemed to be non-preventable, or no fault, the costs will be charged to the vehicle and covered by the Fleet.
 - 5 **Determination of Preventability:** In all cases, determination of preventability and fault will be by the Accident Investigation Committee. If the Committee does not deem an accident non-preventable, for the purpose of this policy, it shall be considered preventable.

Authority/Responsibility to Implement:

- 1 The Accident Investigation Committee has authority to make liability determinations with or without the assistance of the R.C.M.P.
